

Agreement for True!mprov Players

Thanks for your willingness to volunteer to be part of the True!mprov Team. Because True!mprov involves much more than simply the performances, we want to be right up front with our expectations for *all* the improvisers. Please read this carefully. Should you not be willing to make this level of commitment, we understand. This is, however, what we feel is needed in order for the improvisers and True!mprov to be successful.

By signing this agreement, you acknowledge your intention to live consistently with the following expectations:

- Practice with the True!mprov team a minimum of once a week for two hours.
- Perform at least once a month with True!mprov (as scheduled).
- Finish reading Charna Halpern's book *Truth in Comedy* by the end of your training period.
- Refrain from any kind of substance abuse.
- Because True!mprov is an outreach ministry, we expect all improv team members to be fully committed Christians, continually growing in faith and striving to live the teachings of Christ on and off the stage.
